THE SCOTTISH RITE & THE SYMBOLIC LODGE



The Scottish Rite Mason is informed that there is no Masonic distinction of higher prestige than that of the Master Mason, and that the noblest and most significant emblem is the apron of the Master Mason. The Scottish Rite is based upon Blue Lodge Masonry. The conferring of the first three degrees is recognized as the unquestioned prerogative of the symbolic lodge. The Scottish Rite confers the degrees from the fourth to the thirty-second inclusive. At all times it acknowledges the Grand Lodge and the Grand Master as the supreme authority in Masonry. When a mason for any cause loses his standing in the Blue Lodge, he loses his membership in the Scottish Rite.

The Scottish Rite is primarily a rite of instruction by drama. There are no posting lectures to memorize. It interprets the symbols and allegories of Freemasonry in the light of history and philosophy, using the words of the inspired prophets of humanity, and ceremonies of the great religions of the world and significant episodes from history and biography.
